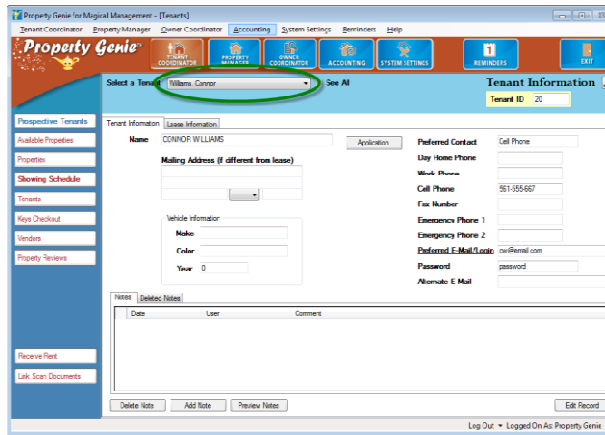




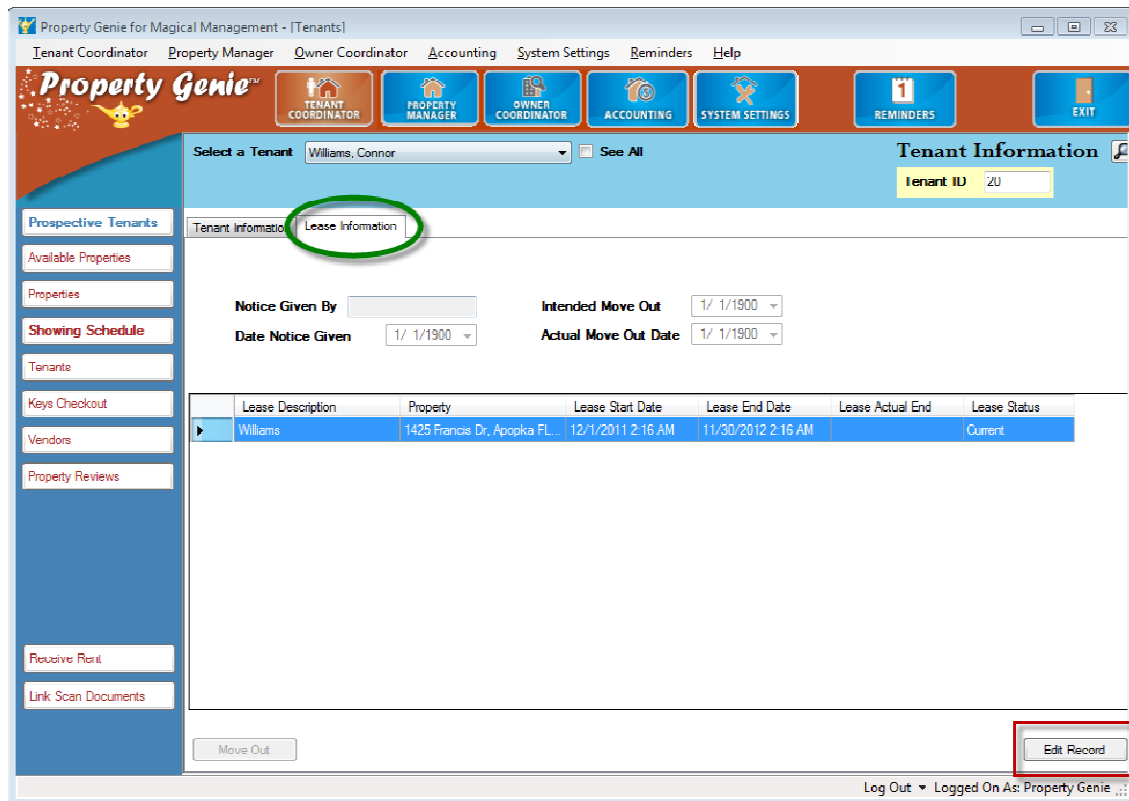
WARNING: At least one tenant must remain on a lease; if your property only has one tenant then you will need to follow the steps of **TERMINATING** the Lease in Property Genie.

Step 1: Open the Tenant Record



Step 2: In the Tenant Record, go to the **LEASE INFORMATION** tab.

Step 3: Click the button labeled **“Edit Record”**





Step 4: According to the move out procedures of the tenant, update the fields labeled “Notice Given By”, “Date Notice Given”, and “Intended Move out Date”.

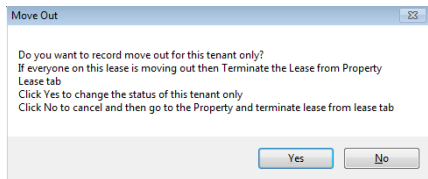
Step 5: Click the button in the lower right labeled “Save Record”

Step 6: Click the button labeled “Move Out”

Step 7: Read the move out prompt, and then click the button labeled “Yes” to complete the Tenant Move out procedure.

Click Yes to change the status of this tenant only
Click No to cancel and then go to the Property and terminate lease from lease tab*
